Zoom is a simple, easy-to-use application that runs on any platform including Windows, Mac, and Android/Apple mobile devices. To Join our Meeting Via a Web Browser:

- At our scheduled meeting time, navigate to: http://join.zoom.us/
- Enter the 9 or 10 digit meeting ID provided by Abdo, Eick and Meyers

To Join our Meeting Via a Mobile Device or Tablet:

- · Install the FREE Zoom Cloud Meetings app from your app store
- · At the meeting time, Tap Join a Meeting and enter the 9 or 10 digit meeting ID provided by Abdo, Eick and Meyers
- You do NOT need to create an account
- If attending via mobile device remember the following:
 - once you enter the meeting, hold your device sideways in landscape format.
 - find a place to prop your phone at the right angle so you do not have to hold it
 - you can swipe left and right to switch from 3 different views including shared screen content
 - when viewing the shared screen, you can zoom in and out like you would while viewing photos on your phone
