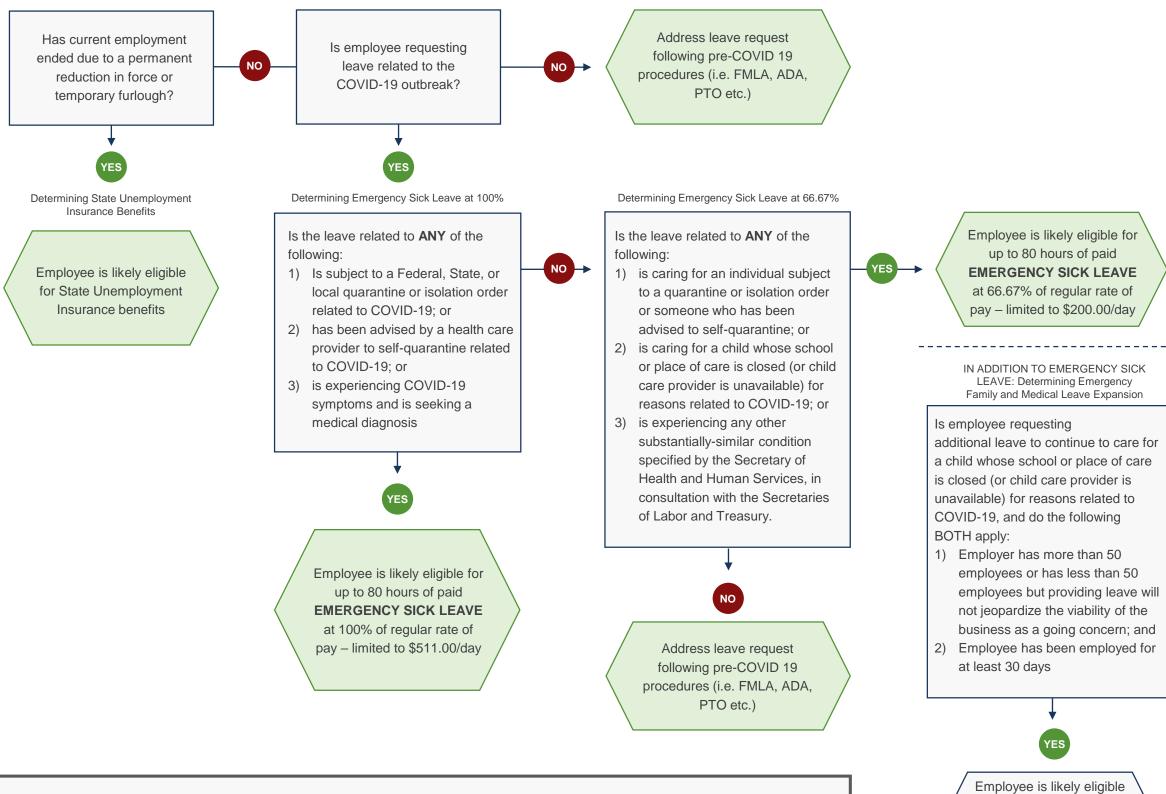
COVID-19 Related Employee Work Leaves

Identifying When and How to Pay Employees

Families First Coronavirus Response Act (H.R. 6201) Effective April 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020





IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- ✓ Families First Coronavirus Response Act (H.R. 6201) is only applicable for employers with less than 500 employees, including public employers.
- ✓ EMERGENCY SICK LEAVE and EMERGENCY FMLA EXPANSION LEAVE must be provided to employees before and in addition to other available paid time off and protected leave.
- ✓ **Private** employers (businesses and non-profits) are eligible for a 100% refundable payroll tax credit for the value of the COVID-19 related (EMERGENCY SICK LEAVE and/or EMERGENCY FMLA EXPANSION) paid leave benefits and employer paid health insurance for all employees **and**, in many cases, owners.
- ✓ Employers are required to post a Department of Labor issued employee notice related to the Families First Coronavirus Response Act (H.R. 6201).
